


ANNUAL REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE COURTS IN THE REPUBLIC OF SERBIA FOR 2017

The basic division of courts is the division into courts of general and special jurisdiction. The courts of general jurisdiction are basic courts, higher courts, appellate courts and the Supreme Court of Cassation. Courts of special jurisdiction are: Administrative Court, Commercial Appellate Court, commercial courts, Misdemeanor Appellate Court and misdemeanor courts.

The Supreme Court of Cassation is the highest courts in the Republic of Serbia.



The Decision of the High Judicial Council, dated December 31, 2017, determined the total number of 2,990 judges' positions in the Republic of Serbia and the total of 2,626 of the defined positions were filled, and 2,586 judges effectively worked in courts. The total of 10,541 court staff was engaged in the court system (1,692 judicial assistants, 5,662 civil servants and 3,187 general employees).


During 2017, all courts in the Republic of Serbia disposed 2,335,760 cases. From comparative figures, there is a trend of increasing the number of disposed cases in trial matters, not counting the enforcement cases.





The trend of increased number of disposed cases


During the same period, the courts disposed 495,708 backlog cases (cases older than two years from the date of the receipt of the initial act). In the past two years, the court system received more than 1,300,000 new cases more than expected, having in mind the inflow of incoming cases compared to the previous years, which burdened the court system and influenced that the number of pending cases in the trial matters is somewhat higher, but the total number of pending cases has been significantly reduced, if we observe the period from 2012 – by 1,247,314 cases









OVERVIEW OF THE NUMBER OF DISPOSED CASES IN THE COURTS IN THE REPUBLIC OF SERBIA
